

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-10

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2016-14
ESTABLISHING THE ELECTRONIC VOTE COUNTING DEVICES**

The Town Council of the Town of Loxley, Alabama, finds as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Loxley on or about the 13th day of June, 2016, adopted Ordinance No. 2016-14, an ordinance establishing the use of electronic vote counting devices authorizing, adopting and directing the use of DS200 Electronic Vote Counting System, a system which complies with §17-7-21 of the Code of Alabama and the use of AutoMARK Voter 87000 System, a system which complies with §17-2-4 of the Code of Alabama.


WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Loxley desires to change from the AutoMARK Voter 87000 System to the ExpressVote System, which complies with §17-2-4 of the Code of Alabama and is consistent with the system used by Baldwin County, Alabama.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Loxley, Alabama, that for all elections held subsequent to the passage of this ordinance, the use of ExpressVote System, a system which complies with §17-2-4 of the Code of Alabama and any regulations adopted pursuant thereto, in place of AutoMARK Voter 87000 System, is hereby authorized for the reporting, accounting and tabulation of any and all election results.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Mayor of the Town of Loxley is hereby directed to file a copy of this ordinance with the Secretary of State as provided in §17-7-21 of the Code of Alabama (1975).

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that all other provisions of Ordinance 2016-14 shall remain in full force and effect.


