JOB SUMMARY:

The purpose of the Communications Officer classification is to receive calls and process requests for emergency/non-emergency assistance and to dispatch emergency medical, law enforcement, fire, or other agency resources. This position requires you to work 12-hour shifts. Shifts may sometimes fall on holidays and weekends. This position is subject to be called in to work during off time and sometimes on short notice.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 18 years or older
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license
- Ability to listen to and understand information then relay information or orders to proper officials in a clear and precise manner.
- Ability to maintain composure in difficult situations.
- Pass a background check, polygraph, and drug screen.
