

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-13

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE BALDWIN COUNTY 9-1-1 GIS/ADDRESSING OFFICE ADDRESSING STANDARDS WITHIN THE CITY OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA, IN REGULAR MEETING ASSEMBLED, AS FOLLOWS;

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the general police powers granted Alabama municipalities, Alabama Code Title 11, Chapter 45, Section 1 and in accordance with Alabama Constitution Title 15, Chapter 70.

SECTION II. ADOPTING THE BALDWIN COUNTY 9-1-1 GIS/ADDRESSING OFFICE ADDRESSING STANDARDS WITHIN THE CITY OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA

The City of Loxley, Alabama hereby adopts the Baldwin County 9-1-1 GIS/Addressing Office Addressing Standards as they currently exist and as may be modified from time to time in the future in order to maintain a uniform system of building numbers for all service locations requiring an address.

The City of Loxley, Alabama shall comply with the Baldwin County 9-1-1 GIS/Addressing Office Addressing Standards.

Baldwin County 9-1-1 GIS/Addressing Office will be the authority on making the final decisions on addressing in the best interest of emergency response.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section subsection, clause, phase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Loxley and publication as required by law.

SECTION V. POSTING OF ORDINANCE

Ordinance 2024-13 shall be posted in three public locations as required by law. Posting locations include Loxley City Hall, Loxley Public Library, and Loxley Post Office.


FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA IN REGULAR MEETING ASSEMBLED, determined that Ordinance 2024-13 to Adopt Baldwin County 9-1-1 GIS/Addressing Office Addressing Standards Within the City of Loxley is hereby Adopted.
