

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-32

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE LAST FULL WEEKEND OF FEBRUARY 2025 AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2012-256, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS TAX HOLIDAY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. In conformity with the provisions Act 2012-256 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2012 Regular Session, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the City of Loxley, Alabama, exempts "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday (February 21, 2025) and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday (February 23, 2025).

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2012-256, except that the time period shall only be as specified in Section 1 above **and not for all years thereafter.**


Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Loxley, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on September 16, 2024.
