

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-39

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MONTHLY SALARY
OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the salary of the mayor of the City of Loxley, Alabama, shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) per month.

Section 2. That the salary of the councilmember elected by the mayor and council to serve as mayor pro-tempore is hereby fixed at the sum of one thousand eight hundred fifty dollars (\$1,850.00) per month.

Section 3. That each councilmember shall be compensated at the sum of eight hundred fifty dollars (\$850.00) per month.

Section 4. In addition to the salary provided for herein, the mayor and councilmembers shall also be entitled to any cost-of-living raises granted to all full-time employees of the city.


Section 5. In addition to the salary provided for herein, the mayor and councilmembers shall be entitled to additional compensation as provided below for the attendance and completion of Certified Municipal Official training established by the Alabama League of Municipalities:

- A. Upon completion of the prescribed courses by the Alabama League of Municipalities resulting in the awarding of the designation of "Certified Municipal Official", the mayor and any councilmember shall receive an additional twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per month to be paid in the same manner as any other compensation for each certification level.
- B. Upon presentation of proof of the awarding of the designation of "Certified Municipal Official", at any certification level, the mayor or councilmember's salary shall be increased as provided herein beginning the next pay period after being awarded the designation.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective on the first Monday in November 2025 and shall continue in force and effect until repealed by action of the council.


Section 7. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable; if any portion of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.


