

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-54

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE THIRD FULL WEEKEND OF JULY 2026 AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2006-574 AND ACT 2017-120, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE STATE SALES TAX HOLIDAY LEGISLATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. In conformity with the provisions of Act 2006-574 and Act 2017-120 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during Regular Sessions, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the City of Loxley, Alabama, exempts "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the third Friday in July 2026 (July 17, 2026) and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday (July 19, 2026).

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2006-574 and Act 2017-120, except that the time period shall only be as specified in Section 1 above **and not for all years thereafter**.


Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Loxley, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on December 1, 2025.


