

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-24**

**AUTHORIZE SUBMISSION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT  
DISASTER RECOVER PROGRAM APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission is accepting grant applications from municipal governments for the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program (DR-4563 and DR-4573); and

WHEREAS, the City of Loxley has identified the need for sewer rehabilitation in the W. Chicago Avenue area; and

WHEREAS, this project was determined to be eligible for funding by the County because it benefits low to moderate income persons in the area and was impacted by Hurricane Sally; and


WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of this project is approximately \$1,000,000 (\$800,000 construction/\$150,000 professional services) according to Engineers at Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is funded, the City is willing to contribute local funds in the amount of \$150,000 to leverage the County grant funds available;


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City of Loxley, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, that the City Council of the City of Loxley authorizes the submission of a grant application to the Baldwin County Commission requesting \$800,000 in CDBG DR funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the Mayor to sign all required grant application documents on behalf of the City.
