**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND MAYOR OF LOXLEY, ALABAMA
REDUCING SPEED LIMIT – BEDROCK BLVD:**

WHEREAS, Bedrock Blvd is located entirely within the Corporate Limits of the City of Loxley;
and


WHEREAS, the City Engineer has studied the geometry and configuration of this roadway known
as Bedrock Blvd. and has recommended that the posted Speed Limit be reduced from 45 MPH to
35 MPH; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Loxley, Alabama have determined it to
be in the best interest of the safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Loxley, Alabama, and
those travelling upon the roadway, for the speed limit on Bedrock Blvd in Stonebridge
Subdivision, to be reduced from the current posted Speed Limit of 45 MPH to a speed limit of 35
MPH.

NOW THEREFORE, it is **RESOLVED** as follows:


1. For the best interest of the safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Loxley, Alabama,
and those travelling upon the roadway, the speed limit on Bedrock Blvd in Stonebridge
Subdivision, to be reduced from the current posted Speed Limit of 45 MPH to a speed limit
of 35 MPH, effective immediately.
2. The City Engineer is hereby authorized to cause new signs to be posted upon the roadway
reflecting the new speed limit of 35 MPH, and to otherwise notify the public through
posting notices, or publication, or both, of the new speed limit.


